Willy Wonka Auditions Arrival and Dismissal Instructions

1) No car lines, stopping, or idling, please. Our parking lot is designed for "park-and-walk" only. It's very dangerous to stop and/or idle in an area that is not marked as a parking space within our lot. It will be dark, and many young, excited kids will be entering/exiting, so please park in a spot. If our lot is full, the map below shows areas along Springfield and Union

Avenues where you can park.

- 2) The auditions are "drop-off only", so please drop your student off, then exit the parking lot promptly (to free up spaces for other audition arrivals and Elefante students), and return one hour later for pickup.
- 3) Please don't arrive early (or late). Adhere to the arrival and dismissal times as exactly as possible; we have classes/lessons going on and can't supervise students who arrive too early.

- 4) If your child is aged 6-9 (the 6:45 audition), please escort them into and out of the building. Enter through the glass double doors on the right hand side of the building. You can identify the doors by the two large snowmen on them. There will also be a sign saying "Wonka Auditions" on the entry door. We'll then take your student into the facility and you can promptly exit.
- 5) If your child is aged 10+ (the 8:00 audition), you do not have to escort them into the building (but you may, of course, at your discretion). Just please make sure that they walk along the sidewalk that abuts our building and not in our parking lot.
- 6) At the 7:45 dismissal time, parents of 6-9 year-olds will enter the building and wait in our dance room for dismissal.
- 7) At the 9:00 dismissal time, parents of 10+ year-olds can either enter the building and wait in our dance room for dismissal, or wait for their child outside of the building.
- 8) Please note that we'll be busy making sure that arrivals and dismissals run smoothly, so we won't have time to chat or answer questions at that time. Feel free to email me with any questions that you may have.
